Dear Mr. Gillen:

The General Service Office of AA in Wellington, New Zealand sent the General Service Office in New York your attached May 6, 1993 letter offering to sell large quantities of The Big Book, Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions and "other titles" to the New Zealand office. While AAWS does not object to your sale of the Mini Edition of The Big Book in the United States under the conditions and in the form previously specified (and to which you have agreed), it has not consented to your sale of its other copyrighted works. You may be unaware that the Third Edition of The Big Book, the Twelve Steps and Twelve Traditions and all of AAWS' other titles are protected by registered copyright in the U.S. As the U.S. is a member of the Universal Copyright Convention and the Berne Convention, AAWS' works are also protected by copyright in New Zealand and all other Convention countries.

You may further be unaware that the first 164 pages and other matter contained in the First Edition of Alcoholics Anonymous are not in the public domain everywhere in the world. In any country which applies its own copyright term rather than the U.S. copyright term, the entire First and Second Editions of Alcoholics Anonymous are still protected by copyright. Thus, in New Zealand (as well as Canada and a number of other countries) all editions of Alcoholics Anonymous are fully protected by copyright.

Although there has been a recent decision to no longer oppose use of the circle/triangle mark on medallions and novelty items please understand that the policy change affects only the circle/triangle mark. AAWS' policy of protecting its copyrighted works and preventing their infringement remains unchanged.

In light of the foregoing, I would appreciate your prompt written assurance that you or your company will not engage in any activities which would infringe AAWS' copyrights.
